Beyond the large expansion of Angola's hydropower facilities, the country is also taking advantage of its potential for renewables. The Ministry of Energy and Water's recent mapping studies reveal that the country could harness 16.3 GW of solar power and 3.9 GW of wind power. By 2030, Angola expects to have its largest solar project ever. In June, the Export-Import Bank of the United States of America qualified a record USD 900-million loan to build two solar facilities with a combined capacity of 500 MW in the provinces of Malanje and Luanda. This 2.17-GW hydro plant is being developed through a partnership between China Gezhouba Group and Angola's Ministry of Energy and Water, with its first phase expected to be commissioned in 2025.
