Which energy company is launching a Bess system in Ireland? Last July, Neoen Renewables Ireland Ltd, a French renewable energy company, announced a 149.6MW BESS on an 8.5ac site near Portarlinton, Laois. According to Bobby Smith, head of Energy Storage Ireland (ESI), one of the main obstacles Ireland's BESS market faces is the lack of route to market for battery operators.
