What does a low battery warning mean? A Low Battery Warning is most often displayed as BAT, LOW BATT, or SYSTEM LO BAT on the touchpad. In addition, many systems will "beep" or "chirp" to alert you that a system or sensor battery is low. This warning signals that your battery must be either recharged or replaced.
