



Government subsidies for solar energy storage charging stations

The Inflation Reduction Act (IRA) includes provisions to revitalize American manufacturing and create clean energy jobs and provides additional resources to improve access to EVs and EV charging infrastructure. The Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL) contains significant new funding for EV charging stations. Key new USDOT programs include the National Electric Vehicle Infrastructure (NEVI) Formula Program (\$5 billion) and the Discretionary Grant Program for Charging and Fueling Infrastructure (\$2.5 billion). If you install property to store or dispense clean-burning fuel or recharge electric vehicles in your home or business, you may be eligible for the Alternative Fuel Vehicle Refueling Property Tax Credit. The property must be installed in a qualifying location. The credit allowed is based on the cost of the property.
