



Moldova wind and solar power generation system

Right now, Moldova has more than 750 MW of installed renewables capacity - more than an 8x increase from 4 years ago. Of this, 529 MW is from photovoltaic (PV) solar panels, 212 MW is from wind energy and the rest is from biogas and hydroelectric. Moldova has proposed an ambitious strategy to increase energy production from renewable sources. The state will provide potential investors with tools and facilities to attract them to invest in green energy production in Moldova's growing market.
