1. INTRODUCTION Energy infrastructure development in Panama, as in the rest of Latin America, was conceived under assumptions of climate stability, anticipating minimal or even no changes in climate behaviour over the long term. How much solar energy will be compromised in Panama in ? What is the electricity transmission system in Panama? Panama's electricity transmission system includes a set of 230 kilovolt (kV) and 115 kV high-voltage lines, substations, transformers and other elements necessary to transmit electricity through the SIN to different delivery points. Who is responsible for electricity distribution in Panama? Three companies are responsible for electricity distribution in Panama: Empresa de Distribución Eléctrica Metro Oeste, S.A. (EDEMET), Empresa de Distribución Eléctrica Chiriquí, S.A. (EDECHI) and ENSA (formerly Elektra Noreste, S.A.). Together, the concession areas cover 41% of the country's surface area, corresponding to 31 077 km². Should power lines be buried in Panama? Additionally, underground cables are less susceptible to damage from external factors like falling trees, further reducing repair needs.
