Will two solar plants be built in Senegal's southern Casamance region? DAKAR, Nov 13 () - Two solar plants with a combined 60 megawatts (MW) capacity and battery storage will be built in Senegal's southern Casamance region to electrify rural areas, Africa-based project developer Axian Energy said on Wednesday. Is a solar energy project in Senegal the biggest in West Africa?
