Figures from the International Renewable Energy Agency state Serbia had deployed a total 137 MW of solar by the end of last year. How much electricity does Serbia get from fossil fuels? The largest in the deal is a 460 MW facility in the territory of Negotin and Zajecar, followed by a 302 MW plant in Bosnjace. Is solar a good option for Serbia?
