



The role of Uruguay's energy storage system

How much electricity does Uruguay produce? The results speak for themselves. Today, Uruguay produces nearly 99% of its electricity from renewable sources, with only a small fraction--roughly 1%-3%--coming from flexible thermal plants, such as those powered by natural gas.
