Is Uruguay a net importer of energy? Once a net importer of energy, Uruguay now exports its surplus energy to neighbouring Brazil and Argentina. In less than two decades, Uruguay broke free of its dependence on oil imports and carbon emitting power generation, transitioning to renewable energy that is owned by the state but with infrastructure paid for by private investment. What are Uruguay's top exports? Uruguay's exports of vehicles posted the third-fastest gain in value, up by 22.6% year over year. The leading decliner among Uruguay's top 10 export categories was animal or vegetable fats, oils and waxes which recorded a -16.6% setback. Where does Uruguay's electricity come from?
