



Vietnam's wind power storage ratio

What is the wind power potential in Vietnam? Subsequently, the Wind Resource Atlas of Vietnam was published in . The total technical potential for wind power development in Vietnam is believed to be at 24GW according the atlas. Developers and experts in the sector, however, perceive this to be overoptimistic and not always backed by existing wind measurements at 60m/80m height. Vietnam's wind power policies are designed to promote the development of wind energy as part of the country's broader renewable energy strategy. These policies aim to attract investment, facilitate project development, and ensure a stable and supportive regulatory environment for the growth of the wind power sector. Key elements include: How much wind power will Vietnam have by ? Notably the revision significantly expanded on Vietnam's wind power targets. Specifically, onshore and nearshore wind capacity by has been revised up from 21,880 MW to a range of 26,066-38,029 MW. Offshore wind for domestic use is now expected to reach 6,000-17,032 MW by , up from a flat 6,000 MW in the original plan. Does Vietnam have a potential for offshore wind development? Despite its current dependence on coal imports, Vietnam is considered to have one of the greatest geological potentials for offshore wind development in Asia. It is estimated that the potential of wind capacity could reach 311GW in the country. How much energy does Vietnam produce? In July , renewable energy in Vietnam generated 24.02 billion kWh of electricity, accounting for 13.4 percent of the country's total power output. Wind power alone contributed 7.3 billion kWh, reflecting its growing role in Vietnam's energy mix, according to data from Vietnam Electricity.
