These are recessed outlets, so they are deeper in the wall than A or B outlets that sit flat on the wall (the kind used in the United States). Which plug sockets can be used in Turkey? Type C and type E plugs can also be used thanks to their compatibility with type F sockets. Typically, type C plug sockets are not allowed to be installed in Turkey: these outlets are not earthed and are therefore considered dangerous. Only type F power points are permitted because they are grounded and therefore significantly safer. What type of power socket do you use in Turkey? Power sockets provide 230 volts of electricity and run on a frequency of 50Hz. Does Turkey have a 220 volt power supply?
