Zambia currently relies on hydropower for 80% of its electricity generation, but recent droughts have shown the limitations of this energy source. In collaboration with the World Bank, the Common Market for Eastern and Southern Africa (COMESA), the Africa Minigrid Development Association (AMDA), and Zambia is charting a promising path toward universal electricity access, with the proportion of the population connected to power rising from 30% in 2010 to nearly 50% today. According to data from CEIC, Zambia's power generation is valued at \$1.2 billion in 2022.
